SUMMARY: Empowering the network of passionate Ambacedores to share Guayaki Yerba Mate with their peer networks both on and around university campuses in the Pacific Northwest, specifically in Washington, Oregon, Montana and Idaho.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The following reflects management's definition of essential functions for this job but does not restrict the tasks that may be assigned. Management may assign or reassign duties and responsibilities to this job at any time due to reasonable accommodation or other reasons.

- Coordinates the interviewing and onboarding of Ambacedores on university campuses as identified by supervisor.
- Introduces students to the Guayaki brand, the practice of sharing mate, and provides information about opportunities available within the Ambacebador Network.
- Reviews and guides Ambacebadores in creating proposals to share Guayaki Yerba Mate with peer networks so that the actions align with the mission and vision of the Guayaki brand.
- Connect collaborators in the local community to the Guayaki brand by enabling them to propose and organize opportunities and events to share yerba mate.
- Stewards the growth of the Graduate Network by providing graduating Ambacebadores resources to share yerba mate in their post-university communities.
- Shares Guayaki brand Yerba Mate from electric trikes on and around university campuses identified by supervisor.
- Traveling and touring with Trikeadores 1-2 weeks per month to introduce the brand to other regions as directed by supervisor.
- Performs other duties as assigned by supervisor.

- Familiarity with yerba mate.
- Ability to communicate and work effectively with university students.
- Excellent problem solving skills.
- Confidence in new and unfamiliar situations.
- Comfortable riding an electric trike loaded with Guayaki products in a congested street setting with cars/vehicles in the area.
- Strong organizational skills; ability to manage priorities and workflow; demonstrated self-starter.

- Versatility, persistence with a smile, flexibility, and a willingness to work within constantly changing priorities with enthusiasm.
- Excellent customer service skills.
- Good judgement with the ability to make timely and sound decisions.
- Creative, flexible, and innovative team player.
- Professional appearance and demeanor.
- Demonstrates ability to effectively communicate and work with different people across many identities, experiences, and backgrounds.

- Calculate figures and amounts.
- Drive for long distances.
